Enclosed please find the Secret Service's production of records in response to Plaintiffs' Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request at issue in the above-referenced case. As noted in the enclosed records, the following categories of information have been redacted:

- 1. The dates of birth and Social Security numbers of visitors, pursuant to FOIA Exemptions 6 and 7(C), 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6) & (b)(7)(C);
- 2. The phone numbers of visitees and points of contact (POCs), pursuant to Exemption 6;
- 3. Identifying information of Secret Service personnel, pursuant to Exemptions 6 and 7(C); and
- 4. Notations by Secret Service personnel (in the "note" column) reflecting a security determination as to whether the visitor requires an escort, pursuant to Exemptions 6 and 7(C), as well as Exemption 7(A), 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)(A).
